**6) Panel review of the physicians' statements**

The Office is preparing an outcome report tentatively titled "The California Report on Coronary Artery Bypass Graft Surgery: 2009-2010 Hospital and Surgeon Data". Preliminary results were provided to each surgeon. Surgeons had 30 days to provide a statement to the Office if they felt their risk-adjusted outcome did not accurately reflect the quality of care they provided. Health and Safety Code section 128750 provides that any physician not satisfied with the Office's conclusion reached in response to his or her statement may notify the Office of that fact, and the Office will request that the Panel review the physician statement and the conclusion of the Office. **To protect the integrity of the process, Health and Safety Code section 128750 requires that individual physician identities not be revealed to the Panel.**

For each surgeon who has so requested, the Panel will review the physician statement and the conclusion of the Office, both of which have been redacted or otherwise anonymized to protect the physician's identity. The Panel will make a determination in each case, to either uphold the conclusion of the Office or reach another conclusion as provided by Health and Safety Code section 128750. (Action Item)
