Where Are They Coming From vs. Where Are They Going?

- Be familiar with the relationship between Source of Admission and Patient Disposition for your facility

Example:

Ratio between 'Source of Admission: Skilled Nursing/Intermediate Care' vs. 'Disposition: Skilled Nursing/Intermediate Care'

- OSHPD system and program readiness
- No change to file format
- Suspension of coding edits

Possible Changes to Reporting

- Adding Physician ID
- Adding Patient Address
- Transitioning inpatient data elements to national standards

Physician ID

- Adding physician identifier for inpatient principal procedure only
- Collect NPI and State ID
- Initially use for procedure volume reporting; future use in physician risk adjusted outcomes studies
- Soliciting feedback

Patient Address

- Adding street address to all three data types
- Use to geo-code
- Use for spatial analysis

Type of Admission	Scheduled, Unscheduled, Infant, Unknown	Emergency, Urgent, Elective, Newborn, Trauma
Source of Payment	OSHPD Defined	Payer Typology

- Authorized by AB 2876, statutes of 2004
- Allows for disclosure of HIPAA limited data sets to California hospitals, local public health departments and certain federal public health agencies (such as CDC, AHRQ)
