


Top 5 Major Employment Sectors

Net Patient Revenue Per Adj Day





Net Patient Revenue per Adjusted Day






Net Patient Revenue by Payer - 2004



Outpatient Visits Per 1,000 Population





Outpatient Visits Per 1,000 Population







Available Beds per 1,000 Population






Average Length of Stay (ALOS)





Net Patient Services Revenue & Expense Per Census Day






Economic Status (Based on Federal Poverty Levels)

Types of Principal Diagnoses 2004



Pregnancies/births account for 28.6% of hospital discharges from facilities in California.


Circulatory and digestive system disorders and symptoms/other reasons account for the top three diagnostic categories excluding pregnancies and births.



(Women between 15 - 44 years)






Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI)



Drug Poisoning Hospitalizations (Age-Adjusted Rate Per 1,000 Pop.)




