NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

for Cal-SEARCH Trainers RFA 10-1307 Applicants

In response to the Cal-SEARCH Trainers Request for Application (RFA) 10-1307, it is the intent of the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD), to award \$24,000 to the 3 organizations listed in the below table.

Funds will support time for one or more individuals within awarded organizations to serve as Cal-SEARCH Trainers. Cal-SEARCH Trainers will assist in strengthening the educational aspects of the program, fostering regional planning and partnerships between Community Clinics and Health Centers (CCHCs) and academic institutions that train primary care health professionals who would eventually support CCHC workforce needs. Cal-SEARCH Trainers will work with the Statewide AHEC faculty to identify and implement local strategies for recruiting and preparing preceptors/mentors and students/residents who participate in the Cal-SEARCH experiences.
