

Advisory Team Meetings

- Advisory Team members prefer to receive a project status update by email or mail quarterly. Quarterly updates will occur in May, September, and December 2010 this year. 2011 quarterly updates will occur in March, June, September and December.
- Advisory Team members also prefer to meet formally once annually. The meetings will occur during the first week each November. Clearinghouse staff will send reminder notices to members by email each September to confirm attendance.
- **Save the Date!** The 2010 Advisory Team meeting will be held on November 3rd in Sacramento. Staff will email meeting logistics in August.

System Development

The Project Team completed the following activities since the Advisory Team meeting on November 18, 2009:

- Identified system requirements to collect data and validate data transmission, format and content submitted by statutory data providers.
- Identified reporting requirements for validation reports to track errors on data transmission, formats and content.

Statutory Data Providers

- The Project Team met with multiple healthcare licensing authorities and education entities. Staff identified specific data available and discussed potential data collection processes and related timetables. Data providers included: Department of Consumer Affairs, Medical Board of California, Board of Registered Nursing, Physician Assistant Committee, Respiratory Care Board, Board of Vocational Nurses and Psychiatric Technicians, California Department of Public Health, University of California Office of the President and California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office.

Legislation Related

- There has been no movement on AB 1310 (Hernandez) since August 27, 2009. AB 1310 requires certain healing arts boards to collect specified information from their licensees and would require those boards and the Department of Consumer Affairs to, as much as practicable, work with OSHPD to select a database to transfer that data to the Clearinghouse.
- **Special Note!** Staff will monitor the recent passage of comprehensive health reform, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, as it relates to the Clearinghouse.
