Monterey County Behavioral Health (MCBH) Mental Health Loan Assumption Program (MHLAP) Criteria Fiscal Year 2016-2017

Applications Due by November 18, 2016

All Mental Health Clinicians are eligible to apply. The following criteria will only be used in the event that demand exceeds resources.

CRITERIA 1: Applicants Who Provide Direct Service and Bill Therapy and/or Medication Support.

- a. Work Hours:** Clinicians, with the exception of psychiatrists, must work 40 hours per week in a public, Monterey County mental health program. Psychiatrists must work a minimum of 20 hours in a public, Monterey County mental health program.
- b. Employment Status:** Must be employed in an eligible provider role, as identified in the MHLAP application, for a minimum of twelve (12) months in a permanent position.
- c. Total Weekly Hours of Direct Clinical Service:** Must meet their agency's productivity requirement and provide a minimum of 20 hours of direct service per week. Part-time psychiatrists are exempt from the 20-hour direct service requirement.
- d. Work Location:** Must work within an eligible MCBH County-operated mental health setting or a contracted, community-based mental health or co-occurring conditions agency. *Those working with adult correctional entities or adults who have offended are not eligible for this program.*

CRITERIA 2. Applicants Who Are Bi-Lingual In Monterey County's Threshold Language.

CRITERIA 3. Applicants Who Provide Services In Hard To Fill/Retain Positions In Underserved Portions of Monterey County.
