

How to build your paper skeleton:

1. Cut out each segment of your skeleton with scissors. (Head, torso, legs, and two arms) Careful not to cut off any tabs, or along fold lines!
2. Fold along lines, with the printed side down. Make sure to fold toward the blank side of the page.
3. Glue or tape tabs to the back side of corresponding edges. Construct each body part as they appear in the image to the left.
4. Once constructed, glue or tape the head on top of the torso. Fold the shoulders out so that they can be attached to the head. Glue or tape the legs to the bottom of the torso, and glue or tape the arms so that they meet both the torso and the head, as illustrated to the left.
5. Enjoy!
