California Student Resident Experiences and Rotations in Community Health (Cal-SEARCH) budgets \$1 Million over four years to place students and residents in opportunities to serve in public mental health system (PMHS) careers.

Goals include:

- Rotation opportunities in public mental health system (PMHS) careers addressed in WET five year plan
 - a. Alcohol and other Drug Use Counselors
 - b. Clinical Psychologist
 - c. Licensed Professional Clinical Counselors
 - d. Marriage and Family Therapists
 - e. Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioners
 - f. Psychiatrists
 - g. Social Workers
 - h. Physician Assistants
 - i. Designated Consumer and Family Member Positions/Peer Support Specialists
 - j. Clinical Nurse Specialists
- Possible opportunity to serve designated mental health shortage areas in (PMHS)
- Serve approximately 312 students and residents over four years (78 per year for four years)
- Each contract will fund student and resident rotations and site hosting each student and resident.
