



# California Dentists: Age, Licensure, Sex, and Location<sup>1</sup> 2014



### Sex (n=36,165)




### Age and Years Licensed (n=36,150)



As of June 2014, there were 36,165 licensed dentists reported by the Dental Board of California. Sixty-three percent of dentists surveyed reported male, 30 percent reported female, and seven percent did not report their sex. The median years of licensure for all dentists is 19 years. The median years of licensure is 25 years for a male dentist, and 14 years for a female dentist.
