NEW AND EXISTING PROGRAMS

- Program Administrator reviewed:
 - Program oversight
 - Student application process
 - Program entry requirements
 - Student cost to participate
 - Program activities
- Programs varied widely across all types
- Proposed approach:
 - Rather than focusing on types of programs that can apply, propose that the application will solicit information on applicant's ability to meet the grant deliverables and have successful outcomes.



POTENTIAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Student focused activities
- Workshops
- Lowering Costs
- Program Responsibilities

- Proposed approach:
 - Applicants propose program activities and how they plan on meeting the grant deliverables in the application.



PARTNERSHIPS

- Some advisory committee members proposed a consortium model and working in collaboration.
- Proposed Approach:
 - Include a partnership component to the grant.



STUDENT STIPENDS

- Opinions regarding stipend amounts and purpose vary greatly.
- Proposed approach:
 - Require stipend amount and set minimum amount per student.
